SELECTIVE SERVICES REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT:

The law requires virtually all male U.S. Citizens (regardless of where they live), and male immigrants residing in the U.S. (permanent resident aliens), to register within 30 days of their 18th birthday. Registration can be completed in the following manners:

- ~Selective Service "mail-back" registration forms available at any Post Office
- ~Mailing back the Reminder Mailback Card the Selective Service sends to young men around their 18th birthday
- ~Checking a box on the Federal Student Financial Aid (FAFSA) form

COLLEGE VISIT OPPORTUNITIES: **REMINDER**

Students are allowed a total of four college days; two to use in their junior year and two to use in their senior year. Students must obtain a visitation form from the Attendance Office and return the form as instructed in order to have the excused college day granted. Requests must be made one to two days before the visitation date. The final college day for the fall semester is December 4, 2009 and the request must be made by November 24, 2009. The final day for the spring semester is May 7, 2010 and requests must be made by April 30, 2010.

This exciting event for juniors and seniors allows students an opportunity to “shadow” Aggies on the Texas A&M campus. Delegates will experience college life while staying on campus and following Texas A&M students in their daily routines including classes and extracurricular activities. Letters of Recommendation - allow 2 weeks for completion of the request; provide a copy of your resume

Transcripts - requests are available in the Registrar’s Office; official transcripts are \$2.00 / unofficial transcripts are \$1.00. Please allow 3 days for processing.
