CAREER CENTER LIBRARY:

The Career Center Library (room 1062 in the Library) can be a helpful resource for information on scholarships, colleges, financial aid, ACT and SAT forms and classes, and military opportunities. It is open to students and parents during school hours.

COLLEGE VISITS:

Students are allowed a total of four college days; two to use in their junior year and two to use in their senior year. An individual campus may not be visited more than one time however, additional visits are encouraged during school holidays and in the summer. Students must obtain a visitation form from the Attendance Office and return the form as instructed in order to have the excused college day granted. Requests may be made one to two days before the visitation date, with the exception of the final week that college days are allowed for each semester. Requests for college days during the final week must be made at least one week prior to the visit. The final college day for the fall semester is December 4, 2009 and the request must be made by November 24, 2009. The final day for the spring semester is May 7, 2010 and requests must be made by April 30, 2010.

TRANSCRIPTS AND LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:

Transcripts are available in the Registrar's office. Transcript requests must be made in writing. Official transcripts are \$2.00 and will be sent directly to the institution. Unofficial transcripts are \$1.00 and may be picked up by the student or parent. Please allow 3 days for processing. When requesting an official transcript, please indicate the mailing and/or postmark deadline.

Students requesting a letter of recommendation must allow the teacher/counselor 2 weeks to complete the request. The teacher/counselor should be provided with a copy of the student's resume when requesting a letter of recommendation.
