### RAP Bucks points to be voted on in February/March meetings

**The February and March RAP meetings will be important meetings for parents and students to attend.** Those meetings are tentatively set for February 20 and March 12. **This is very important!! We will be voting on the rules and the structure of how students can get their hands on RAP Bucks, how many and how they will be able to use those bucks at the after prom party.** Once the decision is in place, there will be no turning back or changing of the rules.

Confusing? Well, not really. Parents & students **GET** RAP Bucks for participating in RAP meetings and volunteering in the fundraising for the RAP '09 event. The RAP Bucks can be USED at the party for prizes.
